Fruit Seven | Faithfulness

How Do We Define It?

Being consistent and clear in what you say and do under the will of God.

What Does It Look Like?

Genesis 22:1-18 & Hebrews 11:17-19

1. Abraham's obedience to God's request to sacrifice his son Isaac.
2. Being consistent in what we do and say, trusting God's faithfulness and reflecting that in our own actions, words and relationships.

How Do We Do It?

We find the power to be faithful by anchoring ourselves in God's faithfulness and grace. Take the call to be faithful one day at a time in the situations and relationships God calls you to.

Let's Unpack It

- What are the moments we are most challenged in our faithfulness?
- A man's selfishness can get in the way of our faithfulness to God. What selfish impulses do you have?
- Are there moments of unfaithfulness that you have experienced which have made you doubt your own ability to receive or live out this fruit?
- Faithfulness assumes doing something for a long time in the same direction. Who are men you perceive to be faithful men? How were they faithful and what was the impact around them?
- What are steps of small or significant obedience you will take to show yourself faithful to God and others?

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
